

展覽介紹

本館辦理「2013新北市全國金屬工藝大賽」,是兩年一度的重要金工賽事。目標延續博物館推展黃金及金屬藝術、建立創意產業的核心宗旨外,也希望加強參賽金屬工藝作品與水金九在地文化特色的連結,開展金工創作的無限可能;因應新北市升格為直轄市,2013年不僅從地方性比賽提升至新北市的規格,博物館更邀請國際金工專業人士,與國內金工及相關領域專業人士共計14位一同擔任評審,期待透過比賽規格與獎金的提升,以及國際評審的加入,鼓勵更廣大的金工創作者參與,讓本賽事不僅成為臺灣金工界的盛事,也可成為與國際金工界相互交流的平台場域。

Introduction

The 2013 New Taipei City National Metal Crafts Competition organized by the Gold Museum is an important metal crafts biennale. The objectives of the biennale are to hold to the museum's core mission—promotion of metal art and the innovative industry, and to unfold the unlimited potential of metal crafts by strengthening the connection between metal crafts and local culture in the Shui-Jin-Jiu area. This year, the competition expands to a larger scale in response to New Taipei City becoming a directly administered city. It invites a panel of 14 judges—international and domestic metal craft professionals, and increases prize money more than ever before, hoping to encourage more metal craft artists to take part in the event. It is hoped that the contest will not only be a grand event for metal craft artists in Taiwan but also act as a platform for exchanges among international metal craft artists.
